All convention participants (GMs, players, organizers) agree to behave in a manner that is respectful of the convention, other participants, and the venue.

In the event one participant feels another participant is acting in a disrespectful or disruptive manner, the offended participant may appeal to the Committee Member on Call (CMoC) for the slot to observe and resolve the situation.

Any abuse of the Respectful Participation Policy (RPP) may be considered disruptive behavior, so participants should not frivolously appeal to the CMoC. Frivolous appeals include personality differences/conflicts between players or between players and GMs.

PrairieCon reserves the right to eject participants from a game or the convention; however, the CMoC may employ other interventions to resolve a situation.

For example, all of the following constitute grounds for expulsion from the convention without refund:

- Violating any federal, provincial, or local laws, facility rules or convention policies
- Failure to comply with the instructions of the CMoC
- Using anything in a threatening or destructive manner against person or property
- Endangering the safety of oneself or others
- Threatening, stealing, cheating or harassing others
- Failure to conduct oneself in a mature manner
